 records clearly indicating the names, occupations, and crafts of every worker employed by them in  
 connection with the public work together with an accurate record of the number of hours worked by each  
 worker and the actual wages paid for each class or type of work performed and deduction made for each  
 worker have been prepared, that these payroll records are kept and have been provided for inspection to  
 the authorized representative of the contracting public body and will be available as often as may be  
 necessary and such records shall not be destroyed or removed from the state for the period of one year  
 following the completion of the public work in connection with which the records are made.

(2) That any payrolls otherwise under this contract required to be submitted for the above period are  
 correct and complete; that the wage rates for laborers or mechanics contained therein are not less than the  
 applicable wage rates contained in any wage order incorporated into the contract; that the occupational  
 title set forth herein for each laborer or mechanic conform with the work he/she performed.

(3) That any apprentices employed in the above period are duly registered in a bona fide  
 apprenticeship program registered with a state apprenticeship agency recognized by the Office of  
 Apprenticeship (OA), U.S. Department of Labor (USDOL), or if no such recognized agency exists in a  
 state, are registered with the OA, USDOL.
